

TECHNICAL RIDER – FANNY M.

The company travels with 4 musicians and 1 comedian, sometimes accompanied by the tour manager or administrator.

TRANSFERTS LOCAUX :

Unless otherwise indicated, the QAH travels in its own vehicle (9-seat Ford van, 2 meters high, registration GH-174-BC).

Parking required near the dressing rooms and rehearsal space.

ACCOMMODATION :

- Hotel accommodation with breakfast included, minimum 3-star hotel, preferably close to the venue.
- 3 single rooms + 1 double room
- Quiet rooms with large beds and internet connection.

CATERING / DRESSING ROOMS :

- 2 dressing rooms with showers, armchairs, towels, mirrors, tables, Wi-Fi, power outlets, hangers, iron and ironing board, and lockable doors.
- Catering (organic and local products if possible): dried fruits, fruit jellies, chocolate, seasonal fruits, fruit juice, cakes, coffee and tea.
- Access to restrooms equipped with toilet paper, sink, and soap.

MEALS :

Unless otherwise specified in the contract:

- 2 hot, complete and balanced meals per day
- 1 meal per travel day
- No specific dietary requirements or allergies

ON-STAGE TEMPERATURE : between 18°C and 30°C

Below or above this range, instruments may crack or keys become unseated.

In the case of an outdoor performance:

- The stage must be protected from direct sunlight, wind, and rain
- Or a backup solution must provide the same protection

STAGE SPACE :

- 3 comfortable armless chairs
- 1 adjustable piano stool
- 1 high stool
- 5 solid music stands (Manhasset type)
- 4 stand lights
- The venue must be ready to welcome the artists for a rehearsal 6 hours before the show (lighting and sound pre-setup, clean stage, etc.).

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS – SOUND

The ORGANIZER must provide:

- 1 mixing console with 7 aux sends
- 1 wireless lavalier microphone (DPA type) for the narrator

The Quatuor Anches Hantées performs acoustically.

FRONT OF HOUSE (PA):

The sound system must be adapted to the venue and the audience size.

MONITORS:

Please provide 2 stage monitors, type MTD 112 or PS15, on stands.
